Hello my friends!

It has been quite a while since we have been together and much has changed! My hope is that you are happy, healthy, creating and as eager as I am to return to our artist family gathering! It has been too long! In order for us to offer this session several things had to be changed. So if you want to come, read on...

COVID requirements: We all have the right to be healthy, happy, and safe. We all have opinions, beliefs, fears and faiths and we all have a right to them. Therefore, we all must do our best to honor them, know our own boundaries and do our best to coexist and not jeopardize the health and safety of each other. With this in mind and each of you close to our hearts, the Board has voted to require participants in this Fall Colony Session to be fully vaccinated. We recommend that you take a photo of your vaccine card on your phone or have your card with you, just in case you are asked for it. It is a good idea to also bring your mask in case we find ourselves in a situation that warrants wearing one.

Location: Henry Jacobs Camp cannot guarantee they will be open for us this fall. The short story involves food service and price challenges, labor shortages and the Delta variant. They did hold summer camp with very strict COVID protocol which you can read on their website. Their administration is unable to confirm our session until later in August. If they were to allow us to come this fall (which I was told was not likely) the total cost for room, board and workshop would be \$850 each. We have been spoiled over the years at H J Camp, but I'm afraid those low prices are a thing of the past....

So.... I started looking around for a temporary venue for this session. No MS state parks were taking group rentals and few have food service. Private venues were either not renting now or could not accommodate our needs.

But, Lake Tiak O'khata in Louisville, MS could! Check out their website at www. ltok.com it is awesome! Byron Myrick and I drove to Louisvile to view the facilities and discuss our needs. Good beds, good food, a space to paint indoors and a beautiful environment. They have it all and then some! I made the proposal to our

Board and they voted YES to booking Lake Tiak O'khata for our Fall Colony!

Price: Your cost this session includes:

- *Your choice of a single or double occupancy for 5 nights, all queen or king sized beds, plush mattress, private bath, tv, WiFi, in room coffee pot and standard hotel amenities (think a nice, new Hampton Inn)
- *14 meals (Monday dinner through Saturday breakfast) served buffet style with our own private dinning room we will use all week located inside a lakeside restaurant. There is available outdoor seating as a part of this public restaurant.
- *Painting space inside a large conference room capable of having 45 work stations with a table and chair, electrical plugs for extra lighting with an adjoining large porch area that could be used for a few painting stations if desired. Everyone will have to bring their own floor covering (plastic or canvas drop cloth) no matter where you set up to paint.
- *Access to hiking trails, tennis court, a lakeside pavilion and gazebo and a 100 acre lake that unfortunately has no swimming after Labor Day
